Candidate for Executive Director – Sam Ford

I'd like to submit the name of Sam Ford as a candidate for Executive Director of NAFA. Not only is Sam currently serving as Chairman of the Board of NAFA, but has many years of business experience as President of his own company and proven dedication to canine health and rescue organizations. All of these have provided him with a unique background, perfect it would seem to lead NAFA on a day-to-day basis and the business decisions that this organization requires.

For those of you who haven't had the opportunity to either race against Sam at a tournament, or chat with him in his visits to NAFA tournaments in the U.S. and Canada, here's a little about him:

He is a graduate of Baylor University, with an undergraduate degree in Chemistry followed by a Masters Degree and work towards a Doctorate.

Sam served proudly in the U.S. Army in Vietnam where he earned a Bronze Star.

In 1981 Sam established Chem Coast Incorporated, which is an independent Testing Laboratory and Marine Loss Control business. It handles hazardous materials within the international ocean trade. He is President of the company and is responsible for the entire operations carried on by three divisions and over 50 employees.

Sam started flyball in 1995 as a team member of Houston Flyball Association, supporting the teams' efforts but not running a dog. In 1996, he welcomed Missy, a Border Collie, into his life. After a year of training he began racing with her in the fall of 1996. Missy is a dog that runs for the love of the game even though she has struggled with Hip Dysplasia. Missy required a TPO when she was less than a year old to strengthen her hip.

Having fallen in love with the breed he became a founder of Border Collie Rescue Texas, Inc. in 1997, serving as the Chairman of the Board of this non profit group who saves the lives of Border Collies in Texas, Louisiana, and Oklahoma. So far thousands of BCs have been rescued through this groups' efforts. It is nothing for Sam to get in his car and drive a BC across the country to their "forever" home. That is the kind of dedication he has.

Due to his reputation and efforts in the dog rescue field, Sam was asked to serve on the Board of Directors of the non profit group Gulf Coast Veterinary Foundation. This foundation supports scholarships for Veterinary students, cutting edge research into animal diseases, and has for years worked to provide continuing education opportunities for Veterinarians in the Texas area.

While actively playing the sport of flyball, and with Missy approaching her 50,000 points, Sam has also been the strong back and driving force in putting on flyball tournaments. Since 1996, he has worked, directed, and led some of the largest tournaments in Region 5 and across the country. Reliant Center World Series of Dog Shows, formerly known as Astrohall, is an example of the size and quality of tournaments held under his leadership. Additionally he has been active in supporting flyball in regions without a large NAFA presence in order to bolster local interest and grow the sport. Each year he has directed or worked to provide flyball in the Memphis area which led directly to the establishment of teams within this area.

On the homefront, Sam has been the leader of the Lone Star Ruffnecks, a club that introduced new ideas and supported improvements in the sport. From simple improvements like assigned crating space in Region 5 to establishing the fact that two ring tournaments can run smoothly with one schedule, he has done nothing but help move the sport forward and encourage its continued growth and development.

“Region to region there are differences in how flyball is played and judged. Working to clean up these issues would be beneficial for everyone, and good for the sport. New ideas are always good to keep the sport of flyball fresh and more importantly moving forward.”

“One of the biggest concerns I have heard is that there are far too many gray areas within the rules which need to be clarified. Better wording of the rules would help to keep a level playing field for everyone in all regions. This is something that definitely needs work. In addition, when issues do arise and come before the Board or one of its committees, it is absolutely crucial that these issues are dealt with using due process, according to NAFA’s Bylaws.”

“I also believe there is a great need for NAFA Judges and Regional Directors to be kept up to speed and up to date on ongoing issues, so that everyone is working with the same information and as much as possible applying the Rules of Racing and NAFA policies equally. Workshops, conference calls, interim bulletins and other tools would allow Judges and Regional Directors to make fair and informed decisions on issues of policy and racing, making the sport of flyball fun, fair and safe for all.”

“Maintaining fairness with a non-political agenda, working for the safety and well being of the dogs, handlers, and the sport are my platform issues. This to me should be an ongoing responsibility of the Board of Directors.”

Kris and her husband Steve Morris pioneered the f i r s t light system t o record reaction times on the start dog and individual times on each running dog. Before that, there had been just a single elapsed time for the team as a whole. This system, which they developed with a client/friend, was set up to track and submit point information electronically. They brought it out in 1997 and received NAFA certification shortly thereafter. Kris' interest in improving the technology in our sport has been evident right from the start.

Professionally Kris is an attorney. Her law firm has offices in both Las Vegas and Reno; she handles trials, appeals, and arbitrations in a variety of commercial litigation settings. Most relevant to the Board of Directors position is her experience in matters involving corporations and corporate governance, insurance, contract disputes, evidence and fair hearing procedures. She serves on the Nevada Board of Bar Examiners, which is the organization that tests and approves lawyers for licensure in Nevada. In addition she acts as a court-appointed mediator in the Nevada Supreme Court settlement program. Kris has served on the committee whose work led to the adoption of the current rules of ethics in Nevada to govern lawyers and on the first ethics disputes committee.

His involvement in both the established and developing regions of NAFA® makes him an excellent choice to represent both given his understanding of the complexities and issues of each.

Scott was not content with just being a competitor all this time. In addition to forming Vermont's first Flyball team (which continues to host some of the most well run & enjoyable tournaments) he became a highly respected judge and has traveled both to officiate and compete in several NAFA® regions. Scott was appointed as Regional Director of Region 13 immediately after the East Coast regions were last realigned.

While Scott's flyball club now fields one of NAFA's top-ranking teams, his genuine love for the dogs and for the sport is clearly evident to anyone who has ever met him. You will see that same grin plastered across his face regardless of whether he is running a dog with his team, judging, or just sitting in the stands watching racing and taking in the atmosphere.

Now that you have a flavor of who Scott Stein is and the experience he has gained from his 10 years in the sport, allow me to impart some of what I have come to know about his core beliefs, the issues that are important to him and his vision for the sport both now and in the future.

As both a NAFA® Judge and an RD, Scott is a strong proponent of good sportsmanship. He recognizes that fun is the key ingredient to Flyball's success and that there simply won't be positive growth in the sport if people and their dogs aren't enjoying themselves. While Scott has competed on teams ranging from the lowest divisions up to Division 1, he understands that issues and goals may differ from team to team. He believes that at the end of the day the objective of ALL teams is to have fun, whether they run for points, time or placements. He feels that a fair and fun atmosphere needs to be the primary goal of every competitor, judge, RD, the ED and every BOD member.

Scott believes that the function of the NAFA® BOD is to set the direction for the sport both now and in the future. Moreover, he recognizes that in order for the sport to continue to move forward an orderly flow of actions must be maintained. Issues must be dealt with promptly to avoid getting bogged down or off-track. He envisions a future for the sport where growth can be better fostered and new opportunities can be explored and realized. The long range goals and business plan for NAFA® need to be continually scrutinized and updated to ensure that NAFA's resources and policies are appropriately allocated both towards our current state and our planned growth for the future.

Scott has had the opportunity to travel to many different regions as both a judge and competitor. He has come to appreciate the unique characteristics that each region has to offer. He believes that while regions must be allowed to retain their uniqueness all regions are entitled to expect uniformity when it comes to the rules of the game. Scott feels that uniformity is essential in maintaining the integrity of the sport.

Likewise, he firmly supports enacting programs that will allow judges the opportunity to hone their skills, remain informed of changes to rules or procedure, provide valuable feedback and network more effectively. All successful corporations ensure that their employees are adequately trained and empowered to perform the functions of their position in the most effective manner possible. Scott is a firm believer that NAFA® needs to enact programs that make their employees (whether judges, RD, or otherwise) more successful.

Scott firmly believes that any changes made to the rules must be of benefit to the sport overall. All regions must be taken into consideration when adopting or amending rules for the simple reason that all regions are required to abide by them.

Scott also feels that much of the suspicion that individuals have regarding the actions of the BOD are due to inadequate communication. Therefore, he feels that fostering an atmosphere where the membership of NAFA® believes that their BOD is working in the best interest of the sport is only accomplished by providing continuous communication between the BOD and the membership of the flyball community. Scott feels strongly that additional postings to the NAFA website and a more regular distribution schedule of the NAFA® news is essential in establishing solid communication between members.

As a NAFA® Director Scott will aspire to being representative of all members. His vote will always reflect what is in the best interest of the game and the will of the people who elected him.

I know that I, along with those whose signatures appear below, have placed Scott's name at the top of our list for the upcoming election. I speak for us all, when I say that Scott Stein should be at the top of yours too!
